# Suspect Wanted for Felony Hit and Run

## Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

June 2, 2023

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Traffic Division are asking for the public's help in identifying and locating the vehicle and driver that fled the scene of a traffic collision leaving a pedestrian with serious injuries in the Rolando area of San Diego.

On Saturday, May 20, 2023, at about 4:57 a.m., a 42-year-old male was lying in the eastbound traffic lanes in the 6300 block of El Cajon Blvd when he was struck by a black SUV.

The driver pulled over, got out of the SUV, and moved the pedestrian to the sidewalk. The driver returned to the SUV and fled the scene.

The pedestrian was hospitalized with serious injuries.

**Vehicle Description:**

The SUV was described as a black mid-size SUV, possibly a Cadillac. See pages 2 and 3 of this release for images of the SUV and the suspect.

**Driver Description:**

The driver was described as a tall Black male.
